HEARING LOSS SUPPORT



Hearing Loss Support volunteers provide information, advice and practical support to all users of NHS hearing aids.

Our volunteers are trained by NHS Audiology Service and as most of them are hearing aid wearers themselves they know from personal experience about adjusting to a hearing impairment.

Our Volunteers can spend as much time as is needed to ensure people know how to make best use of their hearing aids in all sorts of everyday situations. We can offer this support through:

- Home visits - someone will come and see you in your own home
- Residential and Care home visits - to provide help to individual residents
- The See Hear Van - which visits towns & villages across the county
