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# Social Value In Short....

- Public Service (Social Value) Act 2012
- Sets the expectation for all public sector authorities
- Social Value:
  - Involves the consideration of how resources are allocated and used beyond the value of a contract
  - Involves thinking about how each contract can generate wider benefit to the community
  - Its about getting the best value from what we commission in its widest sense

# Social Value in Shropshire

- Established Social Value Stakeholder group
  - This group aims to:
    - Develop a common understanding of social value
    - Develop a set of principles that can be adopted across organisations
    - Oversee the implementation of Social Value locally
    - Support to maximise the benefits and outcomes
    - Increase local knowledge and expertise
- Support the Health & Social Value programme in Shropshire

# Social Value for the CCG

- Shropshire CCG has to date:
  - Reviewed and amended its Commissioning and Procurement guidance to ensure Social Value is built into the process
  - Developed a commissioner checklist to ensure Social Value is embedded at a practical level in all procurement exercises
  - Membership of the Social Value Group
  - Participated in the local bid to secure input from the Health & Social Value Programme
  - Future focus on developing local expertise in Social Value
